My brother committed suicide when I was 18 yrs. old. (He was 19) When I became saddened with grief afterwards my parents worried + put me in an institution. I had no one to talk to about it and what I felt - unanswered questions. Then I was put on so many drugs I could not think at all. Soon the doctors had me so doped up they told my parents there was no hope for me - I would have to stay at the insane asylum the rest of my life. I thank God for coming to my aide and helping me become well again. After seeing this film I realize that my feelings were normal. This experience was very educational + made me feel better about death and dying.

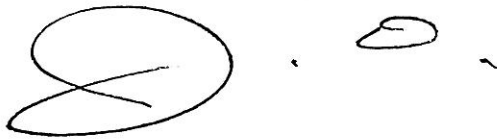

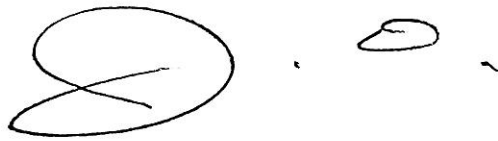
