

Halloween Happening & Workshops

Celebrate Halloween this year with your children. Come to one of Recycle's Costume Making Workshops and an all-day Halloween Happening at the Boston Children's Museum.

Recycle's Costume Making Workshops open to families, teachers and monsters of all ages, will offer all the materials and instruction you'll need to make your Halloween truely "horrible." Come to one of our Pre-Halloween Workshops or drop-in Halloween Day Workshops. Limited to 20 per session. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult. The workshop fee is \$5 per costume. Recycle's Halloween Happening, Sat, October 31, offers a caldron full of special activities including Monster Makeup, Preposterous Pumpkin Design, Ghost Stories and two dropin Costume Making Workshops. Highlighting the day is the Grande Procession at High Noon. A vast assemblage of baleful banshees will attempt to summon back the Great



Recycle Dragon Dorcus (last seen on a jet to Bermuda.) If successful, Dorcus will lead the procession to the Giant's Milk Bottle where the Dragon's Recycled Treasure will be dispersed and an attempt will be made to levitate the Bottle and pop the top.
