AN ACT ENABLING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PROVIDE FOR
FREE ADMISSION TO FACILITIES OF THE CHILDREN'S MUSEUM IN
BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

- 1 The department of education, in the name and behalf of
- 2 the commonwealth, is hereby authorized to contract with the
- 3 Children's Museum in Boston, for the purpose of furnishing
- 4 free admission to the facilities and programs of said Children's
- 5 Museum for all organized school groups and teachers of all
- 6 schools located in the commonwealth. For said purposes, the
- 7 department may expend such sums as may be appropriated
- 8 therefor.
